Nursery Set Up Checklist

- Cot (new or second hand)
- New cot mattress
- Change table (new or second hand)

- Feeding chair (try and put near a plug so you can charge your phone or plug in breast pump)
- Side table near feeding chair
- Night light near feeding chair (make sure it has a red light option)
- Speaker system to play music
- Baby coat hangers
- 3x Fitted sheets
- 3x Mattress protectors (Tip: Place protector down then fitted sheet, then another mattress protector and another fitted sheet. No one wants to change sheets after a blowout at 3am).
- Nappy draw or caddie (nappies, wipes, nappy cream and distraction/chew toy)
- Baby camera/ monitor set up
- Baby beanbag/ rocker/bouncer
- Blanket, snacks and water bottle to be kept by feeding chair.
- Nappy bin with bin/nappy liners
- Difuser to freshen up the room scent

- Teething toy/ rusk
